CROYDON STATION CONSTRUCTION TO CLOSE CEDAR AVEUNE IN BUCKS COUNTY

PHILADELPHIA, PA (June 19, 2009) – Beginning 6 a.m., Monday, June 22, Cedar Avenue will be closed through August to all vehicular traffic between Bristol Pike (PA 13) and Coventry Lane. This project will realign Cedar Avenue with Walnut Avenue to improve traffic flow around Croydon Station.

The work will detour traffic using Bristol Pike, State Road, and Street Road to return to Cedar Avenue.

Riders using SEPTA Route 128 bus service will be detoured using Bristol Pike, Haunted Lane (just before Neshaminy Creek) and State Road in both directions.

SEPTA, government, and community leaders recently celebrated the ground breaking ceremony issuing the start of the extensive \$12 million Croydon Station Revitalization Project that will bring a new state-of-the-art transportation facility to the area.

Croydon Station serves as a vital transit link for riders traveling south into Center City Philadelphia or north to Trenton New Jersey.
